2. Select the year level required for order
3. Please ensure that the students' first and surname is entered
4. Select 'Add to Cart'
5. If purchasing more than one Student Pack, please select 'Continue Shopping', then click 'Home' in the top left corner of the screen, and follow the same procedure from step 3
6. Select 'Proceed to checkout'
7. Your total payment amount required will be displayed on screen
8. Enter your email address
9. Please choose your check-out option – Credit/ Direct Debit available. Ensure payment details are correctly entered
10. You will receive a payment receipt and an order confirmation to the email address you provided
11. Your child's pack/s will be delivered to the school for collection
