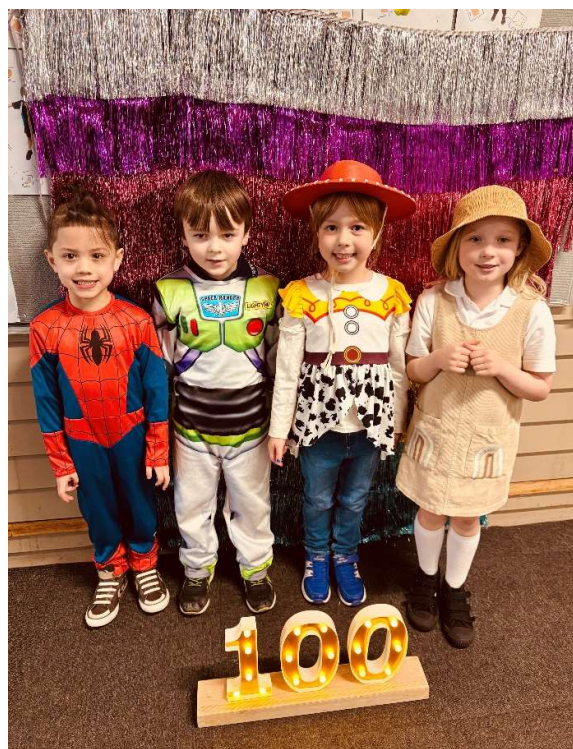
The Adventure theme was designed to encourage students to reflect on how far they have come and the exciting opportunities that lie ahead.
